Melbourne Royal Member Benefits

Parking for Members

Parking is available for Melbourne Royal Full & Show members at Flemington Racecourse at the special member rate of \$20, saving \$10 on the regular rate for parking.

Enter via the VRC Members' Drive gate from Epsom Road. Please note that members' rates for parking are only available to members, not guest card holders. The Epsom Road car park is open from 8.00am – 8.00pm and the Smithfield Road car park entrance is open from 9.30am – 11.00pm.

To receive the discounted member car park rate pass must be displayed on the front windscreen and your membership card must be presented to the gate attendant at the time of entry into the car park.

Members can also present their digital car park pass to access discounted parking.

46 accessible parking spaces are available via Gate 7 on Leonards Crescent. These parks will be available for \$20 a day for members.

Important Parking Information for Saturday 5 October

Due to Turnbull Stakes Day, please note there will be no parking at Flemington Racecourse on Saturday 5 October. Visitors are strongly encouraged to use Metro Trains as the best way to get to the Show.

Additional parking at Moonee Valley Racecourse

For those who still wish to drive, additional parking will be available free from 8.00am at Moonee Valley Racecourse. Please note that parking availability is limited and will be allocated on a first-come, firstserved basis.

A free shuttle bus will move patrons to and from Melbourne Showgrounds and Moonee Valley Racecourse on Saturday 5 October. The shuttle is a short 13-minute journey, with drop-off at Melbourne Showgrounds Gate 5, Langs Road.

Priority entry at Entrance Gates

Members and their guests receive priority access to all Showgrounds gates, meaning less wait time and more fun to enjoy. Your membership card will need to be presented to gain priority access.

Priority access to the Animal Nursery

Members enjoy priority access to the Animal Nursery from 11am on each day of the Show. Members and their guests can enter at the signed entry point at the main entrance. Your membership card will need to be presented to gain priority access.

Complimentary Locker Hire

Access to complimentary locker hire is available to Full Melbourne Royal members, subject to availability. Members must present their membership card at the lockers located between the Showbag Pavilion and Main Arena. Charges apply to lockers in other locations.

Members Reserved Seating

Reserved seating is available exclusively to Melbourne Royal members and their guests at three locations during the Show.

Arena

Located on the south side of the Arena, members have access to a bay of seating giving great viewing access to the after dark entertainment program, including the return of nightly fireworks.

Grandstand

There is seating within the Grandstand allocated exclusively to members and guests. The Grandstand seating is the ideal place to watch the Airtime Freestyle Motorcross Stunt Show and the all-new Sushi Hub Superdog Spectacular.

Kids Theatre

New to the Show in 2024, the Kids Theatre will feature 11 live shows and performances every day. Members will have access to an exclusive bay of seating to view all the shows.

Valued at over \$140, the ACC Showbag is full of cooking ingredients, arts and craft items and cook books.






Melbourne Royal Show Map
