JUNIOR JUDGING

Conditions of Entry

Entries close with David Vanston and Ray Sutherland at 8.30am and Judging will commence at 1.00pm Thursday 20 September 2007.

Entry Free. No extension to the close of entries.

Competitors must be under the age of 21 at date of closing of entries. This event is open to previous winners. There will be two age classes, 12-15 years and 16-21 years.

Competitors must be from a registered Poll Dorset Flock or from a school which has a registered Poll Dorset Flock.

Entrants will be judged on the following system in the junior judging competition:

1. A maximum of 25 points can be awarded for every placing which compares with the Judge's placing. The Judge shall have the power to use his discretion in allotting these points.

2. The Judge shall have the power to orally examine any competitor should the Judge wish to do so.

3. A maximum of 15 points can be awarded for any placing which is one away from the Judge's placing, but will be disallowed if an obviously inferior sheep is placed above the good one.

Entrants will need to be current participants in Lambplan for Group Lambplan figures and 80% of rams in the Exhibitors flock must be tested by Lambplan.

The objectives of the Performance Class are:

To make show selection closer to practical ram selection with the Judge ranking rams as potential sires for use in a commercial prime lamb operation.

To promote improved genetic selection procedures. To allow breeders to compare rams between flocks using Estimated Breeding Values (EBV's).

To maintain the spectacle of the show ring and the interest of ram breeders and the general public.

An outline of the selection method for the Performance Judging Class is shown below:

Visual:	50 points
(fertility, judge to allocate points from 0 to 50.)	
Performance figures:	50 points
MAXIMUM POINTS:	100 points

Points allocated for fertility and EBV's for leanness and growth will be calculated prior to judging. Points allocated for Breed Character and Structural Soundness will be allocated while sheep are in the judging ring. The target market for these sires is the production of Elite Lambs: 22kg carcass weight, fat score 2 and 3.
