CATALOGUES

Catalogues purchased on site will incur a cost of \$12.
Those who do not collect their pre-paid catalogue are advised to contact Competition Administration on 9281 7407 or 9281 7429.

ENTRIES

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ONE ENTRY PERMITTED IN EACH CLASS BY THE ONE EXHIBITOR UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN EACH SECTION.

Exhibits cannot be entered in more than one class.
Exhibits must have been made by one exhibitor unless entered in a Group class.
Exhibits must have been completed within two years of the current Show.
Exhibits must not have been entered at a previous Royal Melbourne Show.
Exhibits must not have been worn, used or marked, except in School Fashion and Design Classes where exhibits may have been worn at other shows.

DEFINITIONS

ARTICLE	Particular item, piece or accessory
SET	A number of items belonging together
GARMENT	Article of clothing
OUTFIT	Set of clothing
NOVICE	Exhibitors with up to two years experience in a particular section or who have not won a first, second or third prize at any Royal Show in that particular section
MASTERS	Exhibitors who have won 1st prize in a particular section at any Royal Show
OPEN	Competition open to all
RESTRICTED	Exhibitors who have special needs
SCHOOL	Students aged from 5 to 18 years inclusive at the commencement of the Show.

EXHIBITS

EXHIBIT TICKETS

The larger portion of the ticket to be retained by you for collection of goods.
ONE small tear off ticket should be attached to your exhibit, unless exhibit comprises of a set, then duplicate tickets are to be attached to each piece of the set.
Framed pieces - Exhibit ticket to be attached by hanging ticket from the lower right hand corner of the frame or by taping ticket onto the front lower right hand corner of the glass. Do not stick to frame as this may cause damage to the frame.
Cookery - On delivery, pins are provided for insertion into cakes.
Solid items - Exhibit ticket must be suitably attached to the lower front right hand of the exhibit.
Textiles - Exhibit ticket must be attached to the front right hand of each exhibit with a small gold safety pin. Duplicate numbers must be attached to all articles comprising a collection or set.

FRAMING OF EXHIBITS

All painting and graphic exhibits must be framed with suitable hanging devices attached to take the weight of the painting. Wire, when tight, must be positioned 5cm from the centre top of the paintings. Copper wire not to be used.
No responsibility will be taken for any work which falls due to faulty attachments.

IDENTIFICATION

Craft Competition - Entries to have signatures covered or be unsigned.
Commercial or Company labelling is not allowed, except in Cottage Industry classes.

INSURANCE

The Society shall not be liable to take out a policy of insurance effectively protecting any exhibitor or exhibits against any claim. Exhibitors are advised to insure their own exhibits against theft, fire or loss.

JUDGING

Art, Craft, Decorated Cakes, Restricted and School Competitions Saturday 13 September.
Cookery and Preserves Sunday 14 September.
Public Judging - Cookery - Saturday 20 September, Preserves - Sunday 21 September.
Other than framed pieces, protective covering fitted to an article must be removed before judging.
With the exception of those engaged by the Society, no person, whether an exhibitor or otherwise, will be permitted to enter the pavilion whilst judging is in progress.
The Judges decision is final.
The Society may, at its discretion, investigate any protest or decision that does not comply with the criteria as set in the Schedule. All parties to be notified of the outcome of such an investigation.

LIABILITY FOR LOSS OR DAMAGE

So far as the law permits, the Society or any official judge, steward, officer or employee, will not be liable in any way for any direct, indirect or consequential loss of an exhibit, or the diminution in the value of an exhibit by reason of

the sale, delivery, disposal or other dealing with an exhibit;
any damage or injury occasioned to or by an exhibit;
the negligence or any act or matter or thing done, permitted or omitted by the Society, or any loss, damage or injury occasioned to or by an exhibitor or person acting on his or her behalf.

NOTES

Criteria as set out at the beginning of each Section under NOTES, applies to the whole Section unless otherwise stated in the individual classes.

PRIZE CARDS AND RIBBONS

Special Prize cards will be awarded for the Best Exhibit in each section.
First, second, third prize cards and ribbons and commended awards will be made at the discretion of the judge. Equal places will not be awarded.
Where no first prize is awarded, second and third prizes will be withheld; only commended certificates may be awarded at the discretion of the judge.

PRIZEMONEY

Prize money as stated in the relevant prize schedule does not include GST.
GST will be added to the prize money for exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes and have provided an ABN number.
Cheques covering prize money will be mailed to exhibitors after the conclusion and clean up of the Show.

REPRODUCTION

The Society may allow the reproduction of any work to the press and television stations, during the period of the Show.

SALES

All exhibits except Cookery, Confectionery and Preserve competitions may be offered for sale.
No sale will take place unless the exhibitor has completed the correct sale forms.
The exhibitor should clearly indicate the price of the exhibit in the space provided on the exhibit ticket. The letters NFS should be used if the work is not for sale. The Society will encourage the sale of work while the exhibition is in progress.
Art Sales - Full price must be paid at the time of purchase. Holding deposits will not be accepted. Miniatures entered as a pair must be sold as a pair.
Cheques covering the sale less 25% commission, plus GST, will be mailed to art exhibitors after the conclusion and clean up of the Show.
Decorated Cake Sales - A Deposit of 20% being commission, plus GST, will be accepted from the purchaser. It is the responsibility of the purchaser to contact the exhibitor to pay the balance and to arrange collection of cake.
Craft Sales - Cheques covering the sale less 20% commission, plus GST, will be mailed to exhibitors after the conclusion and clean up of the Show.
Sales of exhibits are made by the Society solely as the agents of the exhibitor. Subject to the right of the exhibitor to withdraw the exhibit from sale prior to the opening of the Show. The Society retains the right to withdraw the exhibit from sale at any time.
Purchase subject to Terms and Conditions.
Implied Terms - All conditions and warranties expressed or implied by statute, the common law, equity, trade, custom or usage or otherwise are expressly excluded to the maximum extent permitted by the law.
While the Society has endeavoured to ensure that all exhibits are the bona fide property of the exhibitor, or held by the exhibitor under written lease in existence at the time of entry, the purchaser acknowledges that the Society has not made any representation as to the bona fide ownership of the exhibit or that clear title to the exhibit will pass to the purchaser on purchase of the exhibit.

TRANSFERS

Transfers **will not** be permitted unless extraordinary circumstances prevail and only then by direct consultation with the Competition Co-ordinator. The Society has the right to reject any exhibit entered in the incorrect class. If unsure what class to enter please contact Competition Co-ordinator on (03) 9281 7536.
