#### GENERAL REGULATIONS FOR ALL COMPETITIONS ENTERING FOR SHOW

1. Entries will be received in all sections of the Royal Melbourne Show (the "Show") subject to these regulations and the special regulations, rules and conditions appearing at the head of each section and in each class, and on the entry form, and the Society's Conditions of Entry to the Show Grounds posted at each gate. Upon submission of an entry the Exhibitor agrees irrevocably to be bound by all applicable regulations, rules and conditions.

2.

- (a) The Society may in its absolute discretion:
- (i) convey to any body any information concerning any fine, disqualification, withdrawal of a prize or ribbon, handicap, reprimand, warning or any other form of punishment ('penalty') imposed by the Council on or in connection with any exhibitor or;
  - (ii) convey to any body any information concerning any investigation, inquiry or hearing ('proceeding') conducted by the Council whether or not the proceeding was or has been finalised and notwithstanding that the proceeding did not result in the imposition of any penalty on any person or exhibit;
  - (iii) recognise, act upon and enforce any penalty imposed upon any exhibitor or exhibit at any time by any body;
  - (iv) itself conduct such further proceedings in connection with any matter concerning any exhibitor or exhibit, or any person seeking to become an exhibitor or to enter any exhibit, and impose a penalty in relation thereto notwithstanding that a penalty may have already been imposed by that body;
  - (v) enter into reciprocal arrangements with any body in relation to any of the matters referred to in (i) to (iv) above.
- (b) For the purpose of (a), 'body' includes any other society, organisation or body within or outside Australia having similar objects to those of the Society and in particular includes:
- (i) Royal North Australian Show
  - (ii) Royal National Agricultural & Industrial Association of Queensland
  - (iii) Royal Agricultural & Horticultural Society of South Australia
  - (iv) Royal Agricultural Society of NSW
  - (v) Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania
  - (vi) Royal National Agricultural & Pastoral Society of Tasmania
  - (vii) Royal National Capital Agricultural Society

(viii) Royal Agricultural Society of WA (Inc)

(ix) Any breed association or society recognised as such by the Society.

3. Subject to regulations in the relevant Prize Schedule no entry may be changed by the Exhibitor after entries close unless otherwise permitted by the Company.

4. Unless otherwise permitted by the Company all entries must be made in writing on forms supplied by the Company.

5. The entry fee set out in the Schedule of Prizes shall be forwarded with each entry. The date of closing of entries will be found in the relevant Prize Schedule. The entry fee becomes the property of the Company upon its receipt by the Company and fees for withdrawn entries or entries which do not satisfy the conditions of eligibility will not be refunded.

6. All entry forms must be signed by the Exhibitor or his authorised agent. Where an Exhibitor is less than 18 years of age, the entry form must be signed also by the Exhibitor's parent or guardian.

Every person purporting to act as agent of an Exhibitor shall be deemed to have given a warranty of his authority to the Company and the Company is not required to make any inquiry as to that authority.

The Exhibitor is responsible for the correctness of all information on the entry form.

7. Restrictions on the number of entries in any section or class may be made by the Company.

8. Subject to the regulations in the relevant Prize Schedule, no exhibit may be entered in more than one Ordinary Class. Sweepstakes, Special Classes, Trophy Classes, and Championships do not count as Ordinary Classes. Throughout the Prize Schedules, Special Classes are designated with a star (\*). Should any exhibit be sought to be entered in more than one Ordinary Class such exhibit shall only compete in the first class in which its name appears in the Company's Catalogue unless the Company otherwise directs.

#### OWNERSHIP OF EXHIBITS

9. Unless the Company otherwise permits all exhibits must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor at the time of entry or be held by him under written lease in existence at the time of entry and the Company shall have the power to recognize or reject such lease as it deems fit.

10. An exhibit which is not the bona fide property of the Exhibitor at the time of judging or held by the Exhibitor under written lease at that time shall not be entitled to compete without the prior written approval of the Company.

#### LIABILITY FOR EXHIBITS

11. Neither the Company nor the Society shall under any circumstances be liable for:

- (a) the loss of any exhibit;
- (b) any damage or injury occasioned to or by any exhibit;
- (c) any loss, damage or injury occasioned to or by any Exhibitor or person acting on his behalf; or
- (d) without limiting the foregoing, any loss or damage resulting from the sale, disposal or other dealing with any exhibit.



Without prejudice to the foregoing, if the Company removes or causes to be removed from the Show Grounds any exhibit, then each such exhibit shall at all times remain at the sole risk and responsibility of the Exhibitor and the person or persons removing the exhibit shall at all times be deemed to be the agents of the Exhibitor and all acts and omissions on the part of such person or persons shall be deemed to be the acts and omissions of the Exhibitor. Without limiting the foregoing, the Exhibitor shall indemnify and keep indemnified and hold harmless the Company and the Society from all claims whatsoever in respect of the exhibit whether arising by reason of any loss of or injury to or caused by the exhibit or by reason of its transportation, feeding or housing or for any other reason whatsoever.

12. The Exhibitor enters entirely at his own risk. In case any exhibit whilst on the Show Grounds shall cause or be the cause of injury or damage to any other exhibit or Exhibitor or to the person or property of the Company or the Society or any members thereof or to the general public, the Exhibitor of such exhibit shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Company and the Society from and against all damages, costs, claims, expenses and liabilities (including without limitation consequential loss and loss of profits) thereby incurred. The Exhibitor shall be liable to the Company and the Society for any damage or loss occasioned to any of them by the exhibit or Exhibitor or any person acting on his behalf or otherwise representing him.

13. The Company will arrange compulsory Owners' Liability Insurance cover for all exhibitors in the horse, beef cattle, beef carcase, dairy cattle, dog, sheep, goat, pig carcase, alpacas and cat sections. The compulsory insurance levy forms part of the entry fee. Details of the cover provided are shown in the relevant prize schedules.

#### **CONTROL OF SHOW AND CONDUCT OF EXHIBITORS**

14. Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring their family, employees and assistants are familiar with, and comply with these Regulations. Exhibitors may be penalised or disciplined for the actions of their family, employees or agents in contravention of these Regulations. "Employees" includes any person agent or company, whether remunerated by the Exhibitor or not, engaged by, or on behalf of, the Exhibitor to carry, care for or prepare exhibits.

15. Should the Company be of the opinion that any rule, condition or regulation whether set out in these regulations or at the heading of a section or in a class or on an entry form has been broken or not observed or performed then the exhibit or Exhibitor or competitor or all or any of them may be disqualified, suspended for any period, fined, removed from the Show Grounds or otherwise penalised at the discretion of the Company. Any awards may be forfeited and should this occur, any prizes, ribbons or prize cards must be returned to the Company.

16. The Company has the power without assigning any reason to:

- (a) cancel any event or class;
- (b) alter the time or place at which any class or event is to take place;
- (c) alter the conditions of any event;
- (d) remove any exhibit from the Show Grounds;
- (e) alter the date or time for the closing of entries for any section or class or for any particular entry;

- (f) transfer an exhibit and Exhibitor from any class to any other class; or
- (g) decline to display an exhibit.

17. The Exhibitor shall at all times and in all respects comply with the directions and requests of the Company. This shall, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, apply to the entry of the exhibit, the Exhibitor, the competitor, the conditions of event, the conduct of the Exhibitor, the conduct of the event, the decisions of the judge and the awarding of prizes.

18. Should the Company be of the opinion that:

- (a) a statement which is fraudulent, false, erroneous, misleading or deceptive, or likely to mislead or deceive has been made regarding an exhibit, whether or not the person making that statement was or ought to have been aware that the statement was fraudulent, false, erroneous, misleading or deceptive, or likely to mislead or deceive (as the case requires); or
- (b) an exhibit has or may have been tampered with or otherwise improperly dealt with, then the exhibit and the Exhibitor or either of them may be dealt with in accordance with the applicable regulations.

19. Exhibitors must, if required by the Company, make a statutory declaration in such form and with respect to such matters regarding their entries and otherwise as the Company may in its absolute discretion require.

20. The Company reserves the absolute discretion to refuse to accept any exhibit, Exhibitor or competitor for entry in any event or class at the Show and to withdraw, disqualify, suspend for any period (and particularly future Shows conducted by the Company) or otherwise penalize any exhibit, exhibitor or competitor prior to or in the course of any event or upon the conclusion of any event (whether before or after the event has been judged) and generally to adjudicate on and finally determine any matter whatsoever concerning or in any way related to the Show involving the performance or conduct of any exhibit, Exhibitor or competitor or the presence of any drug (as defined in the regulations printed in the relevant schedule or catalogue) in any exhibit.

21. In exercising its aforementioned discretion the Company may if it thinks fit refrain from:

- (a) giving any reason or reasons for the exercise of its discretion;
- (b) giving notice in advance of its consideration of any fact, occurrence, circumstance or state of affairs which resulted in the exercise of its discretion in a particular manner;
- (c) granting a hearing (with or without legal representation) or accepting submissions (whether oral or written) on any aspect of the exercise of its discretion (including matters involving the withdrawal of an exhibit from an event or the imposition of a disqualification, suspension or other penalty);
- (d) allowing an Exhibitor or competitor who is or may be affected by the exercise of its discretion an opportunity to examine, test, clarify, confirm, question or challenge any evidence or interview any expert or other witnesses to which the Company may have had regard in exercising its said discretion;



- (e) otherwise accommodating the Exhibitor or competitor affected by the exercise of the discretion, as required from time to time by principles of natural justice.

If the Company elects in its absolute discretion to accord natural justice to an Exhibitor or competitor then the Company shall unilaterally determine the content and extent of that natural justice and notify the same to the Exhibitor or competitor.

22. The Company reserves the right to rule at any time that any exhibit, Exhibitor or competitor may not compete. This right remains notwithstanding the Company's acceptance of the entry, its inclusion in the Company's catalogue or the issue by the Company of an exhibit ticket, number or any other document.

23. Subject to regulations in the relevant Prize Schedule, an exhibit ticket will be issued by the Company for each exhibit unless the Company otherwise determines. The exhibit ticket will state the number of the exhibit and its sole purpose is to identify the exhibit. The exhibit ticket must be produced whenever required by the Company or the Steward in Charge at the time of judging.

24. Except with the prior written approval of the Company, no livestock or animals, other than livestock or animals entered for the Show, are permitted on the Show Grounds. Domestic animals belonging to Exhibitors are included in this prohibition.

25. No person, whether the Show is open to the public or not, may ride bicycles or skateboards in the Show Grounds without prior written permission.

#### **ACCOMMODATION**

26. The Company is under no obligation to provide space for exhibits or accommodation for people accompanying the exhibits. However, if the Company, in its discretion, does allocate space for exhibits or space for people to sleep, exhibits may be placed and people may sleep only in the areas allocated for such purposes by the Company. Any personal belongings, equipment or property brought by Exhibitors, their employees or families, to the Show Grounds must be kept in the accommodation lockers or other areas allocated by the Company for storage purposes.

#### **JUDGING**

27. The Company may alter the Judge for any particular class at any time if it deems fit.

28. No competitor or Exhibitor or person acting on behalf of any competitor or Exhibitor shall in any way influence consult or interfere with or attempt to influence consult or interfere with the Judge or endeavour to interfere with his freedom of choice or judgment.

29. No exhibit or person in charge thereof shall be equipped with, wear or display anything which indicates the ownership of the exhibit before or during judging unless this practice is expressly authorised in the regulations in the relevant prize schedule.

30. The decision of the Judge as to the merits of the exhibit and the competitor shall be final and binding whether or not such decision was made or purported to be made in accordance with these or any other relevant regulations and no appeal may be made or order for review or similar order sought therefrom to any court of law or other body

on the question of merit of the exhibit or on any matter arising out of or in connection with the manner in which the Judge's decision was made or purported to be made or otherwise.

31. Subject to the regulations in the relevant Prize Schedule, the Judge may award a second or third prize instead of a first prize or may withhold a prize altogether where he considers in his absolute discretion that such prize is not to be awarded.

32. Subject to the regulations in the relevant Prize Schedule, should there be a tie for any placing in any event or class, subsequent placings in that event or class will be awarded such that the next placing will be the sum of the number of exhibits already placed plus one. (For example, if two exhibits tie for first place, the next placing to be awarded is third.)

33. The Judge may make a reserve number, by marking it as such, of the exhibit next in order beyond those to which the prizes are awarded in every class where the number of the entries exceeds the number of prizes offered, if, in his opinion, the exhibit is of sufficient merit to deserve a prize, he may also give commendations, in his opinion, they are deserved.

34. Subject to Regulations 20 and 38, where a prize is disqualified, the Company may promote to that prize the exhibit next in order, whether such exhibit was awarded a prize or reserve number. Exhibits next in order thereafter, whether awarded a prize or reserve number may also be promoted to the prize immediately next in order.

35. All prize cards awarded at the Show shall be exhibited with the exhibit for the duration of the period the exhibit is required at the Show.

#### **PROTESTS**

36. An Exhibitor or competitor may protest against an award won by an exhibit or competitor in the same class alleging infringement of the rules or ineligibility.

37. Subject to the regulations in the relevant Prize Schedule, protests shall be addressed to the Principal Officer and be lodged at his office on the 1st Floor, Administrative Building, cnr. DeGraves Street and Plummer Avenue, Show Grounds, before 12 noon the day after the award in question has been made or on the first day of the Show, whichever occurs later. Such protests shall be accompanied with a deposit of \$20.00 which may be forfeited to the Company if in the sole opinion of the Principal Officer the protest is unfounded, frivolous or vexatious.

38. If any exhibit which has been awarded a prize is disqualified the next in order for award does not necessarily become entitled to that or any prize.

39. The protest and all matters arising therefrom shall be determined conclusively as to all matters by the Company and shall not be the subject of any appeal to any court or any order for review or of a similar nature.

#### **FIRE REGULATIONS**

40. Cooking, heating of water by any means whatsoever, the use of any device involving naked flames, and smoking are prohibited in or near any animal pavilion, stall, pen or locker.



41. The alteration or interference with any electrical wiring, switch, plug or socket is prohibited. The only mains powered electrical appliance which may be used in a locker is a light bulb fitted in the socket provided. Mains powered electrical appliances may only be used in or near any animal pavilion, pen or stall if they are, in the Company's opinion, essential for animal care.

#### **VEHICLE PARKING**

42. Motor vehicles including trucks and stock transports will not be permitted to remain on the Show Grounds after unloading. They must be removed immediately, and will not be re-admitted to load for return until such time as the Company determines. Caravans will not be admitted to or remain within the Show Grounds without the prior written permission of the Company.

43. Any vehicle, including trucks, stock transports, trailers and horse floats, and the contents of that vehicle, located on the Company's property or in any area leased by the Company, shall be at the sole risk of the owner. The Company accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage, including loss or damage caused by the negligence of the Company, its officers, employees or agents to any vehicle, or in the contents of any vehicle, located on the Company's property or in any area leased by the Company.

44. Any vehicle located on the Company's property, or in any area leased by the Company, in contravention of the Company's regulations, terms and conditions of entry or parking restrictions is an illegally parked vehicle and may be removed by the Company, its officers, employees or agents. Any costs incurred by the Company in moving, towing away or storing an illegally parked vehicle shall be paid by the owner of the vehicle.

#### **REGULATIONS REGARDING ANIMALS**

45 - 55 omitted.

#### **DEFINITIONS**

56. "Class" includes event and vice versa and also includes trophy, competition or other award.

"Company" means R.A.S.V. Limited, a company incorporated in Victoria and, where the context allows, its officers, employees, members, officials (including without limitation Judges, Stewards and members of the panel of veterinary surgeons appointed by R.A.S.V. Limited), agents and sub-contractors.

"Principal Officer" means the Company's principal executive officer from time to time and any delegate of such principal executive officer, and includes where the context allows the Society's Executive Director from time to time and any delegate of such Executive Director.

"Exhibitor" includes "competitor" wherever the context permits and also the Exhibitor's agent and anyone acting or purporting to act on his behalf whether or not he is employed by the Exhibitor. Where any Exhibitor is less than 18 years of age, "Exhibitor" also includes the person who has signed the entry form as the parent or guardian of the Exhibitor.

"Show Grounds" means the Royal Show Grounds, Epsom Road, Ascot Vale, Victoria.

"Society" means The Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria and where the context allows, its agents and sub-contractors.

"Show" means the Royal Melbourne Show.

In these regulations the singular includes the plural and vice versa, words importing persons shall include companies and corporations and words importing one gender shall include the other genders.

## Regulations Relative to WOODCHOPPING CONTESTS

(The Wood Chopping Contests are registered with the Central Victorian Axemen's Association Inc. and held under the guidance of Australian Axemen's Association Inc. Rules).

Competitors in the Wood Chopping Contests are advised that arrangements have been made for specially selected timber to be provided for these contests. All timber will be inspected by representatives of the Company on arrival at the Show Grounds, and any not up to standard will be rejected.

### CONDITIONS

101. The General Regulations appearing in this Schedule form part of the conditions of entry. In the event of any inconsistency between the General Regulations and these conditions, the General Regulations shall prevail to the extent of the inconsistency unless the General Regulations provide otherwise.
102. Scratchings must be notified to the Wood Chop Superintendent by 5 p.m. on the day prior to the event. Competitors not notifying scratchings will be fined \$2.
103. The logs and billets will be any variety of timber and any length approved by the Stewards in their absolute discretion. The diameter of all logs will be as uniform as possible.
104. ALL COMPETITORS, must state on the entry form their last win and handicap and a list of their last five performances anywhere, irrespective of Association or State, together with the name of the backmarker. An entry will definitely not be accepted unless the last win and the last five performances for each class of event entered, are stated on the back of the entry form. This applies to ALL Australian and New Zealand competitors.
105. The contest will be chopped in heats and a final, according to the number of entries.
106. All logs and billets will be numbered, and will be drawn for by the Stewards.
107. The first and second competitors in each heat unless otherwise stated, shall compete in the semi-final or final. At the absolute discretion of the Stewards, when there are two semi-finals, they may take one, two or three placegetters to start in the final.
108. No competitor will be allowed to make any axe marks on his log or to the foot holes or dog holes before his handicap starting time as allotted by the Handicapper.
109. No persons, other than competitors and officials, will be allowed in the arena during the contest.
110. Axes must entirely sever logs in two parts; competitors who sever logs with the aid of pushing or pulling will be automatically disqualified.
111. Competitors must be at their places prior to the advertised time of starting. Events will be commenced at their advertised starting time notwithstanding the absence of any competitor.
- 112. All competitors must compete in white shoes, white trousers, white singlets or singlets of recognised State, Association or Club Colours.**
- Exemptions to this regulation will be allowed at the discretion of the Stewards in special cases where singlets are provided by sponsorship or where the clothing is more suitable for a specific event in which cases competitors must remain in the same uniform during the presentation of awards. No competitor will be permitted to display sponsorship of any kind except when provided by the sponsor of an event and singlets with sponsorship can only be worn when the particular event of sponsorship is in progress.**
- Any competitor may apply to the Steward-in-Chief for dispensation in regards to wearing apparel on the grounds of his/her state of health or on any other grounds, in which case dispensation may be granted in the absolute discretion of the Steward-in-Chief.**
- White footwear must always be worn.**
113. In any Association or Club teams race, the Association or Club uniform coloured singlets are to be worn.
114. Any axeman who holds the right to compete in novice events, forfeits the right to compete in a novice of the particular event when he/she has won a single handed open handicap event anywhere in Australia. This rule applies Australia wide and is irrespective of prize money. A competitor who claims to be a novice may be required by the Steward-in-Chief to make a statutory declaration to this effect.
115. The Company may appoint a Disputes Committee for the Wood Chopping Contests and any decision of this Committee shall be final in all respects whatsoever save only for any decisions or directions of the Company. No decisions, directions or determinations made by the Disputes Committee, or the Company for the purposes of the Wood Chopping Contests shall be called into question in any manner or in any proceedings whatsoever.
116. Competitors must use clamps as supplied by the Company in all Standing Block Events.
117. A Competitor who wins an event after the posting of marks may be re-handicapped for any subsequent event or events. The Company reserves the right to re-handicap a competitor before an event has commenced.
118. Every care must be exercised to keep axes and saws covered. Axes and saws MUST NOT be carried among the general public unless so covered. Competitors should note the terms of rules 11 and 12 of the General Regulations. All axes shall have a pin (minimum size 3mm) placed through the axe as near as possible to the centre of the handle area.
119. Logs situated in a reserved area adjacent to the Dressing Room will be provided to enable competitors to test their axes. Competitors shall not be permitted to test their axes in the main arena.
120. In the Underhand events all axemen must finish on their logs.



## ii WOODCHOPPING

121. In a Tree Felling event any axeman chopping in a previously cut board hole will be automatically disqualified.

122. Under no circumstances are axemen permitted to enter the Log Enclosure without the permission of the Log Steward.

123. In all sawing contests saw cuts shall be started as close as possible to the front end of the log and shall not be more than 100mm in from the edge of the top side. Oil may be used on the saw immediately prior to the commencement of the contest. In sawing contests the saw must saw through the log from one side only.

124. In sawing contests the wedger shall stand behind the log and if any wedger in any way touches or guides a saw or touches or guides that portion of the log which is being cut off, the competitor or team concerned shall be automatically disqualified.

Definition: "Behind the log" in this regulation shall be interpreted to mean the opposite end of the log to the saw cut.

125. In the 400mm diameter butchers blocks one member of each team shall open a scarf and cut the log approximately half way through, the first cutting member of the team on ceasing to cut shall retire to his neutral area and visually indicate to his partner, in a manner prescribed by Stewards, that the other team member is to complete the cut by opening a scarf on the opposite side of the log.

126. Save only as provided in regulation 115, any decision of a Steward with respect to any matter related to the Wood Chopping Contests shall be final and any regulations, conditions, rules or guidelines, which may be expressed to apply to the Wood Chopping Contests shall in no way be construed as limiting the discretion of the Stewards to conduct the Contests in such manner as they think fit.

127. Inscribed Sashes and Ribbons, presented by the Company will be awarded to the prize winners of events Nos. 1 to 38 inclusive.

128. Wood Chopping contest times and dates will be announced in the Catalogue.

The woodchopping events will be held from 12 noon Friday 20<sup>th</sup> September through to 4.50 p.m. Saturday, 28<sup>th</sup> September..

Contest times and dates will be announced in the Catalogue which will be available early September and sent to those Competitors who send the sum of \$7.00 with their entry form.
